Contest Guidelines

- 1) Open to all K-12 students in the Mastodon Fair service region who are enrolled in public, private, and home schools.
- 2) Students create a graphic design for a T-Shirt in any medium: markers, pen/ink, paint, photograph of a diorama, etc. Darker/crisp lines on a white background work best. Digital art is accepted. Please send digital art on a CD, as a JPG file, or as a PDF file format as well as the original software file. Include a printed copy of the digital file.
- 3) Size Limitation for all of art is: 8.5” x 11”
- 4) Please include the Mastodon Fair Logo and the current year into your design. You can obtain the graphic file from the www.MastodonFair.org web site.
- 5) All entries must be postmarked by Friday, Jan 15, 2010 and submitted with a copy of this form to:
